Early Childhood Educator

Qualified Early Childhood Professionals guide classrooms of young children, developing curriculum, observing and documenting children's growth, and supervising a team. Early childhood professionals communicate with families, advocate with policy makers, and collaborate with community agencies. Our classes teach development, theories of learning and teaching, and strategies to support social-emotional growth. This program equips students with the skills needed to provide high-quality care and education for young children.

Transitional Kindergarten Teacher

Our Early Childhood Education courses prepare credentialed teachers with the 24 unit requirement now mandated by the California Department of Education. Credentialed teachers who need 24 ECE units to qualify for Transitional Kindergarten classrooms can choose which classes will best achieve their goals. Faculty will work with each teacher to individualize and customize a course of study. Students just beginning their journey to become a credentialed teacher will meet this requirement by pursuing the AS, AS-T and ECE Certificate. For those choosing to become a TK teacher, we provide the classes to get you well on your way toward a B.A. Degree with 26 transferable ECE units.

Preschool Teacher / Infant-Toddler Teacher / Classroom Aide

These are among the fastest growing employment opportunities in California. State requirements and skill preparation can be acquired in a state-of-the-art facility widely recognized as a leader in quality teacher preparation.

Elementary Paraprofessional

Elementary Paraprofessionals assist credentialed teachers with classroom activities, outside games, one-on-one and small group support, planning curriculum, and preparing classroom materials.

Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) or Behavior Specialist

Early Childhood Special Education teachers are in high demand. Students pursuing a degree in this field learn to support children with disabilities through early Intervention, home visiting, inclusion programs, or as a paraprofessional in an elementary school setting. Students will learn to collaborate, use cross-disciplinary approaches, and implement evidence-based intervention practices with a variety of abilities and cultural contexts.

After School Programs

Many school districts and private agencies offer recreational after school programs for children ages 5 to 12. Leaders plan curriculum, help with homework, organize games and other group activities such as cooking, arts and crafts, drama and dance. There is strong employment opportunity in these high quality programs.

Home Visitor / Family Service Worker

A home visitor is a teacher and social service worker all rolled into one. Most of their work is conducted in the home of families qualifying for educational or social services. They must understand child development and be knowledgeable of community resources.

A family worker is a point person that educates families about parenting and child development. They also assist with enrollment, medical and dental services, and resources for crisis intervention. They primarily work in an office or agency setting.


