Health Information Technology (HIT)

The Health Information Technology associate degree program gives students training in coding and reimbursement, quality management, hospital and health statistics, legal aspects of healthcare, healthcare delivery systems, and computer applications including electronic health records.

The program prepares students to work in technical level positions in a variety of healthcare settings. The Health Information Technology program is designed to prepare students for entry into Shasta College's Health Information Management baccalaureate degree program.

The program prepares students to work in management level positions in a variety of healthcare settings.

Enrollment Pathways



There are two pathways to the Health Information Management baccalaureate degree program:

Track 1 - Starting with the Health Information Technology Program (1st year)

This track is designed for students who will be enrolling in Shasta College's Health Information Technology two-year associate of science degree program and are interested in continuing on to earn a bachelor's degree in Health Information Management.

Track 2 - Starting with the Health Information Management Program (3rd year)

This track is designed for students who have completed a regionally accredited two-year program in Health Information Technology and are interested in pursuing a bachelor's degree in Health Information Management.

Students pursuing this track will complete 54 units of upper-division coursework in addition to completing CSU or IGETC general education requirements to earn a Bachelor of Science degree in Health Information Management.
